What is in the share and when?

Arugula	Mid-June—October
Beans	July—August
Beets	July—October
Broccoli	July then again September—October
Brussels Sprouts	October
Cabbage	July—October
Cantaloupe	August—September
Cauliflower	July then again September—October
Carrots	July—October
Corn	August—September
Cucumbers	July—September
Eggplant	Mid-August—September
Garlic	Late August—September
Garlic Scapes	June
Greens (chard, kale, collard, pac choi)	June—October
Herbs (basil, cilantro, dill, fennel, parsley)	June—October
Kohlrabi	July then again September—October
Leeks	Late August—October
Lettuce	June—October
Onions	Mid-August—October
Peas	July
Parsnips	Late September—October
Peppers	August—September
Potatoes	Mid July—October
Radishes	June—July and then again Sept—Oct
Salad Mix	June—October
Spinach	June—July and then again Sept—Oct
Summer Squash	Late July—Mid September
Tomatoes	August—October
Turnips	June—July (salad turnip) Sept—October (storage turnips)
Winter Squash	September—October
Watermelon	August—September

Frequently Asked Questions

Why join a CSA?

Join a CSA if knowing where your food comes from and supporting the local people who labor to produce it is important to you.

Do not join a CSA if you want the cheapest food.

Do join a CSA if you want the freshest, healthiest produce.

Do not join a CSA if you do not like to cook!

Do join a CSA if supporting a local food economy is important to you.

How much food is in a share?

It varies throughout the course of the season. We figure it is enough food for a couple or family of four with young children.

What is in the share?

Your share will consist of vegetables that you see to the left and more. The weekly shares are averaged at about \$30.00 for full shares and \$20.00 for half shares.

Can I choose what vegetables I get each week?

CSA shares are pre-boxed, and ready to be picked up.

What if I miss a week?

Please notify us as soon as you can.

We encourage you to send a friend or relative.

We allow you to miss and make-up two shares thru-out the season, so long as it is the week prior or directly following the missed week.

*Flower bouquets and meat available a la carte at pick-up sites.

Member Agreement

Middle Branch Farm promises to provide members with weekly shares of nutritious, certified organic, local produce.

We will deliver each day (rain or shine,) at the prescribed locations and times indicated.

You, the share member agree to pick up your CSA share at your designated pick up location and time, each week.
